The Board of Trustees of the Egypt-Japan University of Science and Technology (E-JUST)

Announces the Vacancy of the Post of the President of the University.

In its regular biannual meeting on December 4th, 2025, the Board approved the start of the search process for a new president of the university who will assume his/her duties on July 1st, 2026, as the term of the current president of the university expires on June 30, 2026.

The Board approved the conditions and criteria for who will assume this position, in accordance with the regulations approved by the University bylaws, announced on the university's website (www.ejust.edu.eg).

The Council also approved the formation of the committee for the search for the President and his/her selection in accordance with the bylaws and university regulations, from the Egyptian and Japanese members of the Board of Trustees.

It is worth mentioning that the Egypt-Japan University for Science and Technology (E-JUST) was established in 2009 based on a bilateral agreement between the governments of Egypt and Japan as a public research university of a special nature and in full partnership between the two countries. It is the first university of its kind that the Japanese government has agreed to establish and participate-in outside Japan. E-JUST is considered an icon of Egyptian-Japanese cooperation in the field of education, and it is a top priority for both countries.
